## Asia Pacific Vascular Society

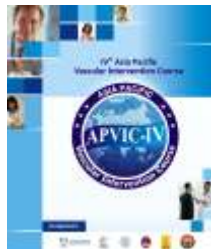

*Over the years, the APVS has collaborated with many national and international societies – viz. International Society of Endovascular Specialists (USA), The Society for Cardiovascular Angiography and Interventions (USA), Indian College of Cardiology (India), Cardiological Society of India (India), Vascular Society of India (India), Endovascular Interventional Society of India (India), Moroccan Society Endovascular Specialist (Morocco).*

*It runs a very successful Fellows Course in association with ISES and SCAI, USA. This course is an internationally popular and sought after course.*

*APVIC intends to be a truly collaborative cross-speciality training event for the “Interventionalists of the future”.*
